Trip Planning - What we wanted

- Mainly self guided but not self supported
- Support from a tour company
 - Carry our luggage
 - Make hotel arrangements
 - Provide a biking route
 - Provide information about sights along the way
 - Provide bikes
- We navigate the route from hotel to hotel on our own using information provided by the tour company
- A few days between tours to travel to the next location and build in an extra day or two in case travel plans go awry
- Plan the tour order to make travel efficient from one tour to the next
- Often build in some off bike days in the middle of a tour if we are in a particularly beautiful, scenic place
- Use trains to get from one tour to the next
 - Each country has an app for their train system that makes purchasing train tickets easy

Trip Planning - Finding our Tours

- Bike Tours.com hundreds of bike tours collected in one place
 - We searched biketours.com for tours that
 - Had scenic beauty,
 - Were in interesting places,
 - Had lots of things to stop and see along the way,
 - Had average mileages of 30 to 35 miles a day and
 - Were places we hadn't biked before
 - Tours are provided by local European tour companies
 - Prices are generally significantly cheaper than many of the US tour companies
- After we decided on our tours we used the provided itinerary and google to find sights to see along the way.

Swiss Lakes by Ebike

- From Lake Geneva to Lake Lucerne
- Averaging 34 miles per day
- Multiple days with 4,000 ft of climbing
- Fabulous mountain views
- Picture perfect scenery and stunning turquoise lakes
- Followed Swiss bike route 3 most of the way
- Mix of separated bike trails, country roads, and village and town traffic
- Two days off the bike in the middle of the tour to explore the surrounding area





- Most days were in the Germanic northern part of Italy




Innsbruck to Lake Garda Across the Southern Slopes of the Alps



- Bike trails, country roads, village roads and some city riding







Lessons Learned

- Number 1 have a good navigation app such as Ride with GPS
 - The tour companies app and maps were not sufficient
- Pack good rain gear you will likely need it
- Be ready to fix small bike issues, tires, adjusting brakes etc.
- Be sure to have a phone with an international plan
 - Navigation on the bike
 - Get around cities, find the right buses, when to change buses and when to get off
 - Finding restaurants
 - Call the tour company if you have a problem
 - Check the weather
- Plan some off bike days to enjoy the area and see sights beyond the bike route

Lessons Learned

- Check the weather at your destination one last time right before you go
- Pack light one carry on and a personal item.
- If you check luggage take all meds, one riding outfit, and extra underwear on plane with you
- Make sure you can lift your full bag and that you can wheel it for blocks, and blocks, and blocks....
